Welcome to Amethi

Amethi is a district in the North Indian state of Uttar Pradesh, situated about 140 kilometres (87 miles) east of Lucknow, the state capital. It is well connected to nearby cities such as Sultanpur, Raebareli, and Pratapgarh.

Established as a separate district in 2010, Amethi serves as its administrative centre. Agriculture forms the backbone of the region, yet it is rapidly developing in education and industry. The local markets, fairs, and temples reflect the vibrant colours and cultural traditions of Awadh.

Nearby, you can explore Raebareli, linked to the legacy of Indira Gandhi, and the Sultanpur Bird Sanctuary, a haven for migratory birds. Pratapgarh is renowned for its guava orchards and religious heritage.

- Prayagraj (Allahabad) (about 130 km away) famous for the Sangam, the holy confluence of the Ganga, Yamuna, and Saraswati rivers, as well as the Kumbh Mela, historic forts, and museums.
- Varanasi (Banaras) (about 220 km away) one of the world's oldest living cities, celebrated for its Ganga ghats, Kashi Vishwanath Temple, classical music, silk sarees, and deeply spiritual atmosphere.

Together, Amethi and its surrounding cities offer a remarkable blend of history, culture, spirituality, and natural beauty—a true reflection of India's timeless essence.
